At **Holy Spirit Convent School, Lonikand**, we are committed to providing quality education that focuses on academic excellence and the overall development of students. We would be delighted to welcome your child to our Senior Secondary Section.

1.1 Admission Process

Step 1:

Obtain an Application form from the school office and fill it with accurate details, as of Class X Board Examination registration.

Step 2:

Submit the filled application form with the required documents (as listed below) at the school office. at the time of submission an appointment for a counseling and aptitude test will be provided.

Step 3:

Provisional admission will be granted based on the student's performance during the counseling session and the aptitude test.

1.2 Eligibility Criteria

The admission will remain **provisional** until the **Class X Board Examination Results** are reviewed. Final admission confirmation will be based on the following cut-off percentages:

- Science Stream: 70% and above
- Commerce & Humanities (Arts) Stream: 60% and above

If the required cut-off percentage is **not met**, parents have the option to:

- 1. Consider a different stream based on availability.
- 2. Cancel the admission within 10 calendar days of the result declaration for a full refund.

1.3 Refund Policy

- A **refund** is applicable only if the child **fails to meet the cut-off criteria** and the parent chooses to withdraw admission:
 - o 100% refund within 10 calendar days of result declaration
 - o 50% refund within 15 calendar days of result declaration
 - o 25% refund within one calendar month of result declaration
 - No refund beyond one month
- **Note:** If the student meets the cut-off criteria but the parent still decides to withdraw admission, **no refund** will be provided.
- Refunds (if applicable) will be processed within 45 days via cheque.
- The Application Form Fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.

1.7 Rules & Regulations

- 1. To secure provisional admission in Class XI, students must pay the Ist Installment Fee
- 2. Admission will be **confirmed** only upon submission of the following documents (in addition to those submitted during provisional admission):
 - o Final Class X Board Examination Mark Sheet
 - o Original Transfer Certificate (TC) (for students coming from other schools)
 - o Character Certificate (for students coming from other schools)
 - o Migration Certificate (other than CBSE)
- 3. If the required documents under **1.7.2** are not submitted, the **provisional admission will be cancelled**, and no refund will be provided.
- 4. Once the academic year begins, **75% attendance is mandatory** as per **CBSE norms**, and it will be strictly monitored.
- 5. In addition to the **school fees**, parents are required to cover the costs of:
 - o School uniforms
 - School transport (if availed)
 - Educational trips & excursions
 - Board/public examination fees
 - Any other expenses related to their child's education at Holy Spirit Convent School & Jr. College
 - Parents may purchase books from a designated vendor who may set up a stall on the school premises for their convenience.
